

2020 MLDC Studio Updated Safety Protocols

Group Classes, Private Lessons & Rehearsals



The following protocols will be put in place for all in studio classes until further notice.

SPACE IS LIMITED. Bring a water bottle to class - the water cooler is closed until further notice.

All classes are subject to adjustment due to the current health situation. In the event of an extended closure, the full class schedule will be converted to Zoom. Registration for Fall 2020 classes assumes acceptance of all policies as listed.



LOBBY CLOSED W/ CONTACTLESS PAYMENT

Our lobby will be closed until further notice. All parents are asked to remain in their vehicles. Drop-off procedures will be provided for each class.

We will limit exposure by taking contactless payment only. All invoices will be emailed and should be paid online. Checks can continue to be mailed to the studio at:

FACE MASKS OR COVERINGS REQUIRED

Face masks will be required for entry.

Upon arrival, dancers will be given a placement number. Shoes, keys, and any other small items will be placed in a designated area in the lobby.

All dancers will be asked to sanitize before entering the studio with their required footwear and water bottles. (see social dis-dancing info below). Dancers will be required to wear face coverings at all times in studio.

Frequent outdoor water breaks will be given during class.

MLDC Faculty members will wear face masks during one on one interactions as well as throughout instruction whenever feasible.



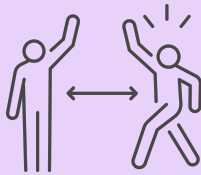
TEMPERATURE CHECKS ON ARRIVAL

All dancers will have temperature checked upon entry. Any dancers or faculty members that register above 100.4 will not be permitted to enter the building.

Dancers and faculty will be asked to stay home if any of the following apply:

- New onset of : fever, cough, shortness of breath, body aches, chills, sore throat, diarrhea, loss of smell or taste
- sharing a household with any person showing any above symptoms
- possible exposure to COVID-19
- High-risk or immunocompromised (alternative zoom will be available)

SOCIAL DIS-DANCING

Upon entry, placements will be given to each dancer. 6 foot square boxes are taped out onto the floor providing a safe dance space to all dancers and faculty.

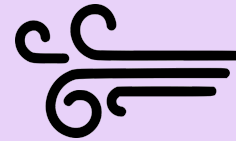
Dancers will be encouraged to maintain social distance as much as possible while also containing movement to each predetermined 6 foot square.



MLDC FACILITY FREQUENT DISINFECTING

MLDC Studios will be frequently cleaned and disinfected daily. High touch areas such as door knobs, ballet barres, and bathrooms will be cleaned between each scheduled class.

In addition to the enhanced cleaning procedures above, studio floors will be steamed and sanitized in between each class. A 10-15 minute switchover between classes will be scheduled to limit cross-contact.



OPEN DOOR AIR FLOW POLICY

MLDC will keep an open front door and open back window to provide for maximum air flow during classes.

During hours of operation, the front door will also remain open to limit high touch areas. Upon arrival, please remain in your vehicle until you receive the all clear to enter. Should you need to wait outside of the building, social distancing stickers will be placed on the sidewalk in front of MLDC. Dancers are asked to keep the currently recommended social distance upon arrival.



CLASSES & COACHING BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

MLDC will open in a limited capacity to dancers by appointment only. All attending dancers must be currently registered and paid in full to enter the facility.

Drop-ins and on site registration will not be available.



LIMITED CAPACITY

Group classes will be limited with space available based on registration. Group classes will maintain the same dancers each week to avoid cross-contact.

Adjustments to this policy will be dependent on the current CDC and PA Department of Health guidelines.



HYBRID CLASSES WITH ZOOM AVAILABLE

All programs will have access on zoom daily so that each family can determine attendance based on their comfort level.

Zoom will also be available for any dancers who need to remain home due to the above requirements and symptoms checklist.
